**REMINDERS****When Your Student Has An Appointment.....**

**When your student has an appointment, please let the student know the time they need to leave Fairview and any logistics regarding the appointment prior to the school day.**

**Fairview is an open campus, so:**

- **You do not need to call to let us know they are leaving ( but do have your student bring back a note from the doctor, DMV, courts etc. to excuse the absence, and, as a courtesy to that period teacher, have the student alert their teacher that they will be leaving during class)**
- **We are not able to call or go to the classroom to get your student out and/or let them know of appointments you have scheduled. Please make sure to let your student know what time they need to leave and where you are meeting.**

### **When You Need To Drop Off An Item For A Student ....**

Please bring the item to the front desk. We have a spot to hold items until students pick them up from the main office. You will need to communicate with your student that they have an item in the front office to pick up. We DO NOT take items to students in their classrooms or give them a message that there is something for them to pick up because it is an interruption in the classroom.

### **When You Are Picking Up/Dropping Your Student For School ....**

The senior lot is the ONLY drop-off/pick-up location for Fairview. Do NOT use the horseshoe in front of the school, that area is reserved for Special Education Busses. Do NOT use the pull in for the RTD bus stop, that space is for RTD use only and it disrupts the flow of traffic. Do NOT pick up or drop off in the staff parking lot on the Southern Hills side of the school. Thank you for your cooperation and help keeping our students safe. Please see the attached map for locations listed above.

Watch out for cars and pedestrians when coming to campus and leaving campus. Before and after school there is a lot of vehicle, bike, and pedestrian traffic. We want to keep everyone safe.
