## TESTING UPDATES

### PSAT/NMSQT

Fairview will be hosting a PSAT/NMSQT test this year on Saturday, Oct. 16th. This is an **optional** test that is designed to qualify 11th-grade students for the National Merit Scholarship. Only current Juniors are eligible to register for the test for a fee of \$35. There are a limited number of tests available and registration will occur on a first come first serve basis. The registration deadline is Friday, October 8th @4pm.

To register for the PSAT, please go to Fairview's RevTrack page and select the PSAT Reg activity. After you have registered please print out your receipt and bring it to the Counseling Center help desk to complete your registration with Kristine Ferfache. All questions regarding the test and

We are excited to have streamlined our AP and IB Exam Registration System. **Please follow these directions carefully** to ensure ordering and receipt of the proper exams.

**AP and IB Exam Registration are now open.** All students taking an AP or IB Exam **must complete [these forms](#)**. **Students, please click on this link and complete the forms CAREFULLY.**

**The above link takes families to the FHS RevTrak system**--there are two items on the left-hand side of the screen, AP and IB. If a student is taking 1 or more of each kind of exam (AP and IB), then both forms and payments need to be completed. If you are only taking 1 kind of exam (AP or IB), only that form and payment needs to be completed.

**Any students taking one or more AP exams MUST also complete the MyAP sign up through the College Board and join AP Classroom, using the Join Code given to you by your teacher:**

Most students have already completed the above step. If you do not sign up via MyAP, we cannot order an exam for you. **This is a mandatory step for AP exams. Please ask your teacher if you have questions about AP or IB exam registration for your class.**
