Updates from the Admin Team

October 22, 2021

Dear Parent / Guardian,

Our school is administering a nationally developed school climate survey from the American Institutes for Research ('Safe Supportive Learning Survey' for grades 5-12 and 'Conditions for Learning Survey' for grades 2-4). The district selected these surveys to better understand the current climate of schools across the district. The surveys will ask students about their perceptions of school on topics such as student engagement, school environment, and school safety. Surveys will be administered online by the Office of Student Assessment and Program Evaluation in Boulder Valley School District.

Your child will be invited to participate in a survey during regular school hours on November 10th. Once your child logs into the survey, they will be asked what they'd like to do, either take the survey or not. If your child agrees to participate, they will spend about 10- 15 minutes completing the online survey. Your child does NOT have to answer any questions that they do not wish to answer. For younger students, your child's teacher will read survey questions aloud while students follow along online.

Student responses to the survey will be confidential. Your child's survey response goes to the Office of Student Assessment and Program Evaluation where staff will delete identifying information and distribute summary results directly to our school.

Therefore, no one at our school will know how your child responded to the survey. Your child's answers will be combined with the answers of other students at our school and across the district to produce reports that will help us better meet the needs of all students to have a safe and engaging learning environment at school.

Estimado padre / tutor,

Nuestra escuela está administrando una encuesta de clima escolar de los Institutos Americanos de Investigación (Encuesta de Aprendizaje de Apoyo Seguro para los grados 5 a 12 y la Encuesta de Condiciones de Aprendizaje para los grados 2 a 4). El distrito seleccionó estas encuestas para comprender mejor el clima actual en las escuelas en todo el distrito. Las encuestas preguntarán a los estudiantes sobre sus percepciones de la escuela sobre temas tales como la participación de los estudiantes, el entorno escolar y la seguridad escolar. Las encuestas serán administradas en línea por la Oficina de Evaluación de Estudiantes y Programas en el Distrito Escolar del Valle de Boulder.

Se invitará a su hijo a participar en una encuesta durante el horario escolar regular durante la semana de Nov 10th. Una vez que su hijo inicie la sesión en la encuesta, se le preguntará qué le gustaría hacer, ya sea que conteste la encuesta o no. Si su hijo acepta participar, pasará unos 10- 15 minutos completando la encuesta en línea. Su hijo NO tiene que responder a ninguna pregunta que no desee responder. Para los estudiantes más jóvenes, el maestro de su hijo leerá las preguntas en voz alta mientras los estudiantes la siguen en línea.

Las respuestas de los estudiantes a la encuesta serán confidenciales. Las respuestas en la encuesta de su hijo irán a la Oficina de Evaluación de Estudiantes y Programas, donde el personal borrará toda información que pudiera identificar a su estudiante y distribuirá los resultados resumidos directamente a nuestra escuela. Por lo tanto, nadie en su escuela sabrá cómo respondió su hijo en la encuesta. Las respuestas de su hijo se combinarán con las respuestas de otros estudiantes en nuestra escuela y en todo el distrito para conseguir información que nos ayudará a satisfacer las necesidades de todos los estudiantes en un entorno de aprendizaje seguro y participativo.

TESTING UPDATES

From the Honor's Office

To all Fairview Families with students enrolled in a culminating AP or IB exam course:

We are excited to have streamlined our AP and IB Exam Registration System. **Please follow these directions carefully** to ensure ordering and receipt of the proper exams.

AP and IB Exam Registration are now open. All students taking an AP or IB Exam **must complete [these forms](#)**. **[Students, please click on this link and complete the forms CAREFULLY.](#)**

The above link takes families to the FHS RevTrak system--there are two items on the left-hand side of the screen, AP and IB. If a student is taking 1 or more of each kind of exam (AP and IB), then both forms and payments need to be completed. If you are only taking 1 kind of exam (AP or IB), only that form and payment needs to be completed.

Any students taking one or more AP exams MUST also complete the MyAP sign up through the College Board and join AP Classroom, using the Join Code given to you by your teacher:

Most students have already completed the above step. If you do not sign up via MyAP, we cannot order an exam for you. **This is a mandatory step for AP exams. Please ask your teacher if you have questions about AP or IB exam registration for your class.**

Please note: we are not able to order your exam(s) until the above steps have been taken, and payment has been made.
